Alex McLean (bro of d'd Hector) is only one to take land. 10 of orig are going home in the ships. Chas McL, Aug'12, "greatly disappointed by so grt a no withdrawing after having entered into engagements with him altho your Lordship didn't order persecutions".p.451 [did McG return to Scot via ships in 1812; or via Ont in 1815?]

McDonald about it & he told me that he was not obliged to give me any but when he had it to spare that he would sell...it & during the whole winter & almost spring I was obliged to...buffalo met (meat) out of the plains. ...four...little better... summer three of my...was in the fever & I went to Capt Millis (Myles) McDonell & begged 1 lb of oatmeal which he refused to give me any of it. Had it not been for the Canadians whom I tred (traded) sugar & salt & at the same time Captain McDonell had oatmeal flour & barley & I had nothing in the world to give them unless fish without salt or anything. Now my agreement with Lord Selkirk was that I would get one year provisions out of the ... Also LF Selkirk at Sligo 22 June'12; "I have rec'd from Neil McK <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>30 (torn) as pt of passage fee for the family of 7, & for the remaining £40 he has

granted his letter of obligation; "Selkirk". Their oldest 4 kids didn't come with them (had 12

kids total).

Arch McG's 2 dau's (who made their X mks) establish long lines in Man. Cath wed John Pritchard in Man. John had run away from his Shropshire home against his parent's wishes & came to Cda in 1800. He had been the middle 1 of 13 kids SO Sam, a Shrewsbury hatter. He became a clerk with the NW Co. In 1804/5 he was sent W by the XY Co & spent time at Ft Souris. The HBC had a fort at Brandon House & NWC had Assinaboine House (built by David Thompson 1798). Pritchard was lost on the plains in '04/5 while going to Oak L, but was saved by Indians. The NW Co prevented him settling at Red R so he went to Montreal but returned 1814/5 to warn the settlers & gov'r of impending fur trader wars. A contempory said 'little Pritchard is eager to go to Red R; full of love & enthusiasm; has a japon ?? lady there who he admires. A Metis friend saved his life at the 7 Oaks Massacre in '16. He's in London in '19; giving Parl. evidence. Became Selkirk's London rep. Selkirk's family had supported the Fr rev'n. Selkirk was 30 when he got his title in 1799. He had a single-minded stubborness re ends & an imaginative flexibility re means. By 1810 Selkirk controlled the HBC. The first RR settlers had arrived in 1811. 'Japon' meant a dark color & hence an Indian lady. It was likely this 'country wife' factor that saved his life at 7 Oaks. She must have d. or been 'divorced' in late '14 or early '15 because he wed Cath in

May'15. Alfred Silver in "RR Story" p.148 says this Japon lady was Cath McG\*, an illegit DO Wm or another McG fur trader.

This book & his follow-up one "Where the Ghost Horse Runs" are about Cuthert Grant jr (1793-1854) & 7 Oaks (1816); who founded St Francis-Xavier. Alex Ross's "The RR Settlement" is boring. 1815 brought a gen'l eco collapse in Br & thousands of disbanded soldiers & sailers. >1815 gov't assisted emigrants. [111]

In Aug'20 Pritchard returned & set up the Buffalo Wool Co (a failure).

July'25 Mrs P. & kids & he work in garden & fields.

3 cows, 3 calves; fishing & hunting.

Winter 1825/6 was very hard & the '26 spring flood did much damage; house, etc destroyed & ruined Buffalo Wool Co. This may be when Arch, his wife & 2 boys return to Scot.

Aug'28 no theft or crime

July'32 setting up a tallow co.

Arch is back at Cameron by Moy in '35 (or d.; for sure <'38)

He called a crofter in '72. Mary, b.1773 (2nd dau of Hector??)

As a younger son he had to make his own fortune but got some help from Col John, a distant cousin. Found success in America & owned the "Sunflower" estate in Jamaica, which he bought from a Mr Taylor.

His grd-son, Lachlan, wrote LT neice "your paternal grd-dad was Lachlan of <u>Daviot</u>. The estate was his own. He was by b., pos'n & ed'n a gent. He wed the DO of the chief of the McPherson's. His maiden sister Janet left her estate to the step-mom (Kennedy). He had to sell his estate due to #2's extravagance. He had an estate in America left him by Col McG\* which he sold. After it failed, L. jr sailed to Ldn with £2500 & then went to Oz. L. sr was strongly built man, scarcely middle height, strong marked features, not unhandsome, studious habits, proud & distant & with a very bad temper".

He d.19 Nov 1815 in Jamaica (source Caribbean web, 12 Oct 98?; paper 2 Feb'16); at Sunflower, St Thomas, East Jamaica, 5<sup>th</sup> SO late Arch M'G\*, Esq. Daviot, after trying to salvage his failed estate there (slavery was abolished in 1807). Son said he d. an hypochondriac (causeless depression).

His Will (made Apr 1813 in Ldn) leaves the bulk of his estate to wife (Anna McK McG\*), son Rev Lachlan, & dau Mary Randall.

It states these are his "lawful" kids & that Jim/Lachlan & Janet are his "reputed" kids & both these latter are under age 21. In The McG\* & McIntosh Traders by Amos/J Wright jr; states that Lachlan, on 10 June 1797 'sponsored the bapt of a malatto man named James, probably his son.' Could this be James/Lachlan below? It goes on to say Lachlan sponsored other such slave bapt's during the period 1797-1810. Wife was exec for his sister Miss Janet, see below. (Robt McG\* wrote article on him for Clan Chattan mag Fall 1997 p.191. (Clan McG\* mag of Aussi, 1998, has more details on him.
