Supplies: Below are the supplies I used to make this project. Use what you already have on hand to customize your album.

- Paper trimmer, scissors
- Ruler
- Score board, bone folder (or other tool for folding paper)
- Thick scrapbook paper or cardstock for making the pages and tags (I used Boardwalk Sherbet by Craft Smith to make the pages and some 65lb cardstock (Recollections at Michaels) to make the pull-out tags.
- 2 pieces of medium weight chipboard for the front and back covers (you can also cut up a cardboard box)
- Two-sided tape, tacky glue or glue gun
- Hole punch and eyelet setting tool
- 4 eyelets for the cover, 2 eyelets for each page
- Ribbon for tying the album
- 2 magnets
- Ink pad (I used Ranger Ink in Frayed Burlap)
- Mini envelope printables available for purchase from my website (http://www.scrappinrabbit.com/p/shop_9.html) or from my Etsy shop (<https://www.etsy.com/ca/shop/TheScrappinRabbit>)
- Decorative edge punch for the pull-out tags (I used Abstract Flowers punch by EK Success but use what you have on hand)
- Embellishments: flowers, die cuts, bling, etc.
(The image of the envelope for the album cover is on the last page of this document – print on paper or cardstock of your choice.)

Cutting Dimensions:

Cut from thick scrapbook paper or cardstock:

- Base pages (cut 6 as I did, or whatever number of pages you want): 4-3/4" w x 8" h
- Pockets (cut one for each page): slightly wider than 5-1/4" x 2" h
- Pull-out tags (cut one for each page): approx. 4-1/2" w x 3-5/8" h including punched border along the right edge
- Wrappers for front and back covers (cut 2): 7-3/4" w x 6" h
- Inside cover liners (cut 2): about 5-5/8" w x 4" h – video shows how to cut without measuring

Cut from medium chipboard (or cardboard):

- Front and back covers (cut 2): 5-3/4" w x 4-1/8" h

Cut from a piece of scrap paper:

- Template for making album envelope: 11" w x 11" h
(I would have loved to provide you with a printable template for the large envelope, however the size won't fit on a regular printer.)
