

Oven Recipe Card Box

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Supplies I used

- 3 sheets of 12x12 medium weight chipboard (I used black)
- Cardstock (standard 65 lb is fine) for hinges and embellishments
- Scrapbook paper for embellishing the oven
- Paper trimmer, scissors
- Scoreboard and bone folder
- White glue, two-sided tape, hot glue gun
- 6 brads and 6 eyelets for stove knobs
- 4 brads and 4 beads with wide centers for the stove feet (or go to <https://youtu.be/ZiaCtjZB5fU> where I show how to make feet for your projects)
- 4 buttons and die-cut circles for stove elements (use any large flat buttons you have, or draw some stove elements)
- 2 small brads for door handle
- 2 magnets (for door)
- Small piece of acetate or plastic for door window
- Small piece of fabric to make the tea towel
- Embellishments: flat-back pearls, clock embellishment (or download an image of a clock from the internet), die-cut heart

Cutting sizes

Cut from medium weight chipboard:

(I also include measurements for scoring the chipboard below, but start by cutting the pieces first. In the video tutorial I show how to score the chipboard - you can refer back to the scoring dimensions later if you need to.)

- Base (bottom and 2 sides of oven): 10-3/4" w x 9" h
On 10-3/4 inch side, score at 6-1/2".
Rotate 90 degrees to the left and on 9" side, score at 4-3/4".
- Side piece (other 2 sides of oven): 10-3/4" w x 4-3/4" h
On 10-3/4 inch side, score at 6-1/2".
- Lid: 8-11/16" w x 6-7/16" h
Score 1" from the edge on all four sides.
- Control panel: 8-11/16" w x 6" h
On 6 inch side, score at 1", at 3" and at 4".
On 8-11/16 inch side, score 1" from the edge on the left and the right sides.

Cut from cardstock:

- Hinges: the hinges will be visible. My cardstock is the same colour as the chipboard, but if you use a different colour you can always ink or paint exposed edges of chipboard)
 - For base:
 - 4 hinges each 4-3/4" long x 1-1/2" w
 - 2 hinges each 4-1/4" long x 1-1/2" w
 - 2 hinges each 6-1/2" long x 1-1/2" w
 - For lid:
 - 4 hinges each 2" long x 1" w
 - - 2 hinges each 4-1/2" long x 1-1/2" w
- For control panel:
 - 1 hinge 6-11/16" long x 1-1/2" w
 - 4 hinges each 1" long x 1" w
 - 2 hinges each 2" long x 2-1/2" w
- Oven door: 4-3/4" w x 3-3/4" h
- Black background when opening oven door: 4-1/2" w x 3" h
- Template for cutting window in oven door: 3-1/4" w x 2" h
- White panel where stove knobs and clock are attached: 4-1/2" w x 1-1/4" h
- White panel where oven knobs and heart are attached: 3" w x 1/2" h
- Category cards: 6-1/4" w x 4-1/4" h

Cut from acetate or a piece of plastic:

- Oven door window: 4"w x 2-3/4"h

Cut from scrapbook paper:

- Inside of oven door: 4-1/2"w x 3"h
- Liner inside bottom of the oven: start with approx. 6-3/8"w x 4-3/8"h and adjust to suit after the bottom of the oven is assembled
- Covering paper (matting) for the oven: mark with a pen where paper needs to be cut, leaving a 1/8" border of chipboard showing.
