

Scrapbook Pocket Mini Album
5" w x 6" h x 3" thick
By ScrappinRabbit (www.scrappinrabbit.com)

Following are the dimensions of the pieces you will need to construct the album. If you are punching decorative borders along the edge of your pockets, you might need to adjust the width/height of the cardstock to accommodate your punch. This is explained further in the videos.

BASE PAGES AND ADD-ONS:

Cut from cardstock: (you can also use thick sturdy scrapbook paper for the pockets instead of cardstock)

- Base page front (cut 6): 4" w x 6-1/2" h
- Base page back (cut 6):: 4" w x 5-1/2" h
- Horizontal pockets on pages 1 and 7 (cut 2): 5" w x 3" h
- Corner pockets on pages 3 and 9 (cut 2): 3" w x 3" h
- Vertical pockets on pages 5 and 11 (cut 2): 2" w x 6-1/2" h
- Flaps on pages 2, 4, 6, 8, 10 and 12 (cut 6): 4-1/4" w x 5-1/2" h
- Pull-out tags (cut 6): 4-1/8" w x 5-1/8" h
- Pocket inside the back cover: 5-1/4" w x 3" h

HINGES: (cut 1 of each size indicated below)

- 1-3/8" w x 5-1/4" h
- 2-1/8" w x 5-1/4" h
- 2-7/8" w x 5-1/4" h
- Base: 2-5/8" w x 5-1/4" h

ALBUM COVERS AND SPINE:

Cut from chipboard or corrugated cardboard:

- Front and back covers (cut 2): 4-3/4" w x 6" h
- Spine: 2-5/8" w x 6" h

Cut from piece of plastic or Tyvek

- Hinge protector: 6-1/2" w x 6" h

Cut from scrapbook paper:

- Cover wrappers (cut 2): 5-3/4" w x 8" h
- Spine wrapper: 5" w x 8" h (I used cardstock to cover the spine, but you can also use good quality scrapbook paper).
