Other properties such as Faillie, Wester Gask, Inverernie were left to the "heirs of the Clan Chattan but a court ruled there was no such thing as a clan in law. This enabled the the female line to succeed & these estates were soon sold.

But, Dunmaglass, Easter Gask & Wester Lairgs were tailized to males & whoever won them got to be chief.
